### **FOUNDATIONAL COURSE**

### **FOUR CORE COURSES**

\_\_\_\_\_ **LIT 260 *Introduction to Literary Study***

*Prerequisites: English 201 and any 100- or 200- level LIT course*

\_\_\_\_\_ **LIT 300 *Text and Context***

*Prerequisite: LIT 260 Introduction to Literary Study*

\_\_\_\_\_ **LIT 305 *Foundations in Literature and the Law***

*Prerequisite: LIT 260 Introduction to Literary Study*

\_\_\_\_\_ **LIT 400 *Literature Seminar* OR LIT 405 *Literature and the Law Seminar***

*Prerequisites: These courses require LIT 300 or LIT 305 plus senior standing (90 credits completed) or permission of the major advisor. Students pursuing the concentration in Literature and the Law must take the Literature and the Law Seminar, though it is open to all students provided that they first take LIT 305. Students may opt to take a second senior seminar as an elective.*
